

Pied Piper Swim School Policy and Procedures For Scheduled Classes

PPE requirements:

All instructors will always wear mask during class and have their temperature taken daily.

All students will wear mask in the facility unless they are swimming in a class. They will have temperature check upon arrival and sanitizing will be required. Please be sure that your child has used the bathroom before coming to class.

Social Distancing Requirements:

Students and coaches must maintain 6 feet distance when possible. There will be designated markers for the students. There will be a designated area for the students to bring their swim bag to class. Swim bags will be required to have the follow:

Parent/ child

1. Kickboards ,belts, towels, swim diapers, hair ties(if needed) they will not be available for hand out
2. Water toys for pool use only, bubbles, small items they can hold onto in the pool with their hands.

Regular Class

1. Kickboard,belts(if needed),towels, Face Mask are required accept when swimming in the pool.
2. They will be assigned a color cone with a number. Please go over the color and number with your child.

Guideline for Arrival:

Your child must be ready to enter the facility ready to get temp check and sanitize. They must have the bathing suit already on. Everything that is taken off will go in their swim bag except their shoes. You can only arrive 10 min ahead of class. This is to ensure proper social distancing. Parents are required to stay in the car unless you are in a Parent/child class. We will have a designated sign for the exit which will be located on the south side of the building. There will be no parents or visitors allowed in the facility.

Bathrooms will be limited to emergency. There is no changing in the bathrooms. Changing stalls are not available. Face Mask are required for the bathroom.

Bathrooms will be disinfected frequently as well as the facility.

Waivers will be signed by all adults that bring students.

Students or adults with a temp of 100.4 degree or more will be sent home.

Criteria that must be met by student or anyone residing in their household to be eligible to attend class

Cannot have had contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID -19 in the last 14 days

Cannot have a temp. over 100.4 degrees, a cough or difficulty breathing in the last 14 days

Cannot have traveled to COVID-19 hot spots in the last 14 days. Any students or staff member experiencing any symptoms of a fever, recent cough, unusual fatigue, headache or has had exposure to someone who has had symptoms should remain at home or seek medical treatment.

If any student/parent/child or staff has a fever or symptoms of illness they cannot come to class for 14 days after the fever or symptoms have ceased.

Staff and parents must see a physician to be cleared for class diagnosed or suspected to have COVID-19. For us all to stay healthy and able to keep swimming we ask that we all practice social distancing when they are away from the pool. Should we feel as though the social distancing is not adhering to the guidelines, they or their family's participation in Pied Piper Swim School class will be suspended.

Positive test procedure; Should someone test positive for COVID-19 within the class session the following measure will take place. The individual should let the staff know immediately. The facility will be shut down for no less than 24 to deep clean. There will be No Refunds.
